Prep Work

- Select outfit early (not morning of)
- Make sure clothes are ironed and neat
- Break in new shoes before event
- Start collecting professional clothing a little at a time
- Bring a portfolio or folder with printed copies of your resume



Hygiene

- Shower & wash hair
- Brush teeth & use mouthwash
- Trim & clean nails - no designs or extreme lengths
- Trim beard
- Use deodorant & avoid colognes

Accessories

- Turn off and put away cell phone
- Belt & shoes should match
- Wear dark colored socks
- Minimal jewelry & other accessories

Did You Know?

Most Colleges have a professional dress closet that you can borrow clothing from for a period of time.

Overall

- Clothing should compliment one another
- Consider more neutral color pallets
- Shoes should be scuff-free and coordinate with accessories
- Recommend low heel & no tennis shoes
- Clothing should fit comfortably, avoid very tight or very baggy clothing
- Recommend slacks over jeans
- Never wear shorts, leggings or pants with holes
- Skirts are typically knee length or longer
